Weather Cancellation Policy

As you will be aware, the weather in Edinburgh can be unpredictable at any time of year.

We aim to run our sessions year round and in all weather conditions with the intention of avoiding cancellations where possible. Players are strongly advised to dress appropriately for the conditions (e.g - waterproofs on rainy days and sunscreen on sunny days with high UV).

However, in situations where there is potential danger to players (e.g - extremely high winds) or tennis courts become unusable (e.g - snow or flooding) we will cancel sessions in the interest of ensuring a safe environment for players.

Refund Policy

Once a term, holiday camp, event, competition or clinic has been paid for we are unable to offer a refund.

In the event of a weather cancellation, as described above, players and parents may credit the pro-rata amount against a payment for the following term or an alternative holiday camp, event, competition or clinic.

Term Calendar

Generally, our programme operates on a termly basis with fees being due prior to the term beginning.

Whilst precise dates will change with the calendar year, our programme schedule is as follows.

Term One - January & February

Term Two - March & April

Term Three - May & June

Holiday Camps - July & August

Term Four - September & October

Term Five - November & December
